Family Peer Support Specialists have lived experience raising a child or youth who has emotional, developmental, behavioral, substance use, or mental health care needs. They understand the difficulties of navigating a complex system to find help for their children.

- Provide compassion and understanding of the unique experiences and needs of your child and family
- Assist you to advocate for your child and family to access support and services at home, in the community and at school.
